CROSBY FORESHORE – RESTRICTED AREA

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT ALTERATIONS TO THE EXTERNAL LIMITS OF THE CROSBY FORESHORE ARTWORK KNOWN AS ANOTHER PLACE HAS NOW BEEN COMPLETED.

THE ALTERATIONS TO THE ARTWORK ON THE FORESHORE INVOLVED THE REMOVAL OF EIGHTEEN CAST IRON STATUES AND MARKER POSTS FROM AN AREA OF THE FORESHORE BETWEEN CROSBY COASTGUARD STATION AND THE ENTRANCE TO THE RIVER ALT.

THE REMAINING STATUES WILL COVER AN AREA OF THE FORESHORE STRETCHING NORTH FROM SEAFORTH DOCKS RIVER WALL TO CROSBY COASTGUARD STATION.

THE LIMITS OF THE RESTRICTED AREA WILL CONTINUE TO BE MARKED BY YELLOW POSTS 500 METRES APART HAVING A YELLOW CROSS TOPMARK AND EXHIBITING A YELLOW FLASHING LIGHT.

THE NORTHERN LIMIT OF THE RESTRICTED AREA IS MARKED BY TWO YELLOW POSTS IN POSITIONS $53^{\circ} 29.725'N$ $003^{\circ} 04.022'W$ AND $53^{\circ} 29.775'N$ $003^{\circ} 03.630'W$.

ALL OWNERS AND USERS OF WATERBORNE CRAFT ARE ADVISED NOT TO NAVIGATE WITHIN THE RESTRICTED AREA.
